### **ABRAHAM AND ISAAC**

Video/30 min./1999/Children

An emotion-filled tale of complex obedience and unreserved sacrifice, this heart-rending story is one of the greatest tests of obedience, faith and trust in God. Abraham passes the test and renews God's promise that he will become the father of many nations. The core message is God honors our obedience.

### **ACOLYTES, GREETERS, USHERS**

Video/23 min./1990/Youth-Adults

A basic training tool for church acolytes, greeters and ushers. Provides general overview of responsibilities and duties for each of these positions and shows their importance to local church ministry and outreach.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: CHARITY**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"The Emerald Lizard" and "Mr. Straw" — When a cold front moves through Spring Valley, making life miserable for the poor, Zach and Annie decide to collect donations of clothes from their neighbors. When Annie accidentally includes her favorite leather jacket and later regrets it, she must come to terms with the true meaning of "charity."

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: CITIZENSHIP**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"The Stone in the Road" and "The Story of Cincinnatus" — When Annie's father is called for jury duty, the family vacation is put on hold. Excited about taking a trip, Annie doesn't understand why her father can't just postpone his jury duty, prompting several stories up at Plato's Peak about citizenship, the civic virtue.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: COMPASSION**

Video/30 min./1996/Children

"Androcles and the Lion" — When Zach watches a dreadful fire destroy an immigrant family's home, his indifference about getting involved slowly wanes, as Plato recounts inspiring stories of compassion. "The Good Samaritan" (Bible), who renounces prejudice in favor of saving a life; the selflessness of a young girl in "The Legend of the Big Dipper" (Norse); the tale of "Androcles and the Lion" (Greek), a demonstration in compassion given and kindness returned; and the poem "The New Colossus" all help Zach grasp the significance of reaching out to those in need.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: COURAGE**

Video/30 min./1996/Children

"William Tell" — When Annie takes a tumble during a track race, she loses her confidence and lets fear and embarrassment keep her from persevering. Her friends help restore her spunk and bolster her determination by sharing heroic tales of gallantry, valor and dauntless spirit. Theseus taking the "bull by the horns" in The Minotaur (Greek); Aesop's "Brave Mice"; the boldness of legendary archer "William Tell" (Swiss); and the inspirational poem "If" help to convince Annie that the brave only become so through acts of courage.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: DETERMINATION**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"Proteus" and "Jinkyswoitmaya" — Zach and Annie take off on a biking trail, determined to complete it before sundown. But when Zach has an accident and sprains his ankle, he and Annie tell each other stories to bolster their determination so they can get out of the forest before nightfall.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: DILIGENCE**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

“The Discontented Pig” and “The Sculptor and the Sistine Chapel” — Zach decides he wants to be a photographer. He is diligent in his study of the art until the school newspaper offers him what he considers a thankless assignment taking pictures for their new classified ads section. Zach is disappointed. With guidance from Plato and Aurora, he realizes he should apply himself to his assignment with the same diligence he originally had for learning photography.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: FAITH**

Video/30 min./1997/Children

Annie’s faith is put to the test after her friend dies unexpectedly, leaving her feeling alone and bewildered. Plato and the crew share stories of faith and perseverance like “Daniel and the Lion’s Den” (Bible), about a man who inspires others by holding his faith above all else; and “Harriet Tubman” (American), whose unyielding faith motivates her to lead numerous slaves to freedom. Annie also finds comfort in the words of the “23rd Psalm” (Bible), helping her see that since God is with us we are never alone.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: FRIENDSHIP**

Video/30 min./1997/Children

Annie realizes that friendship is about what you give, not what you have, after a “fair weather friend” jilts her before a canoe trip. Plato helps Annie see that “a friend in need, is a friend indeed” in the tale of “Waukewa’s Eagle” (Native American); the importance of being open-minded when choosing friends in “Why Frog and Snake Don’t Play Together” (African); that trust and loyalty make true comrades in “Damon and Pythias” (Greek); and to treasure “New Friends and Old Friends” (poem).

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: GENEROSITY**

Video/30 min./1997/Children

When Zach and Annie decide to deliver food to a homeless shelter, they get caught up in planning their rewards. Plato helps them discover the true spirit of giving in “Rocking Horse Land” (English), about a boy who learns the value of bringing joy to another; “Old Mr. Rabbit’s Thanksgiving Dinner” (English), where a rabbit’s bounty gives wonderful meaning to the holiday; the “Gift of the Magi” (American), in which a couple’s sacrificial gifts reflect their love; and the purpose of a day well spent, in the poem “Count That Day Lost.”

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: GRATITUDE**

Video/30 min/1998/Children

“The Discontented Stonecutter” and “Cornelia’s Jewels and The Little Loaf” — Zach plans to invite many classmates to his birthday party because more guests mean more gifts! Then his parents tell him that they can only afford a small party of Zach’s closest friends. Disappointed, Zach retreats to Plato’s Peak where he hears several tales that demonstrate the importance of gratitude.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: HONESTY**

Video/30 min/1996/Children

“The Indian Cinderella” — To escape blame for breaking his father's camera, Zach concocts a story instead of telling the truth, prompting his friends at Plato's Peak to help him "focus" on the importance of honesty. Promises kept and promises broken are explored when Plato acquaints Zach with the stories of "The Frog Prince" (English); "George Washington" (American) and his infamous cherry tree; and a poem about "Truth." But Zach's appreciation for this virtue is clinched when he heeds the lesson imbued by "The Indian Cinderella" (Native American), whose honesty is rewarded by love.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: HONOR**

Video/30 min/1998/Children

“The Honest Woodman” and “Honest Abe” — Zach needs a score of 90 on his history test to get an A-minus on his report card and just make the school honor roll. And it looks like he’s done it ... until he realizes his teacher added the points wrong and he only got an 87. If he tells, he’ll lose the honor he wanted so badly to win. But Plato’s stories help him realize there’s a more important kind of honor at stake.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: HUMILITY**

Video/30 min./1997/Children

When Annie is elected class president, she lets her new-found power go to her head, prompting a lesson in leadership from Plato. Annie discovers appearance isn't everything in Hans Christian Anderson's "The Emperor's New Clothes" (English); an appreciation for the taste of "humble pie" in "King Canute at the Seashore" (English); that bad choices can hurt others in "Phaeton" (Greek); and to look at one's abilities realistically with the help of the "Serenity Prayer."

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: INTEGRITY**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"For Want of a Horseshoe Nail" and "Charlemagne and the Robber Knight" – When Annie's handmade weather vanes sell like crazy at the school fair, she cuts a few corners to keep up with demand. Later, when the weather vanes begin to fall apart, Annie is confronted by angry customers who want their money back. Humiliated, she retreats to Plato's Peak where she hears several tales about the concept of "integrity."

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: LEADERSHIP**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"The Tower to the Moon" and "The Gordian Knot" – Zach complains about the leadership abilities of the team captain of his water polo team. When he later gets elected to the position of captain himself, he learns firsthand what it means to lead others.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: MODERATION**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"The Spider's Two Feasts" and "The Goose That Laid the Golden Egg" – When Annie's obsession with baseball results in a drop in her grades, Plato relates two tales that demonstrate the value of moderation in all things.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: PATIENCE**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"Anne Sullivan and Helen Keller" and "How the Brazilian Beetles Got Their Coats" – When Annie volunteers to help a younger schoolmate with his math, she grows increasingly impatient with the boy and loses her temper. Annie regrets offering to tutor the boy, until she hears several stories from her friends at Plato's Peak about the virtue of patience.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: RESPECT**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"Diamonds and Toads" and "Please, The Bell of Atri" – When Zach and Annie are rude to a friendly junkyard man who is helping them build a go cart for an upcoming race, Plato is concerned and tells several stories about the virtue of respect.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: RESPONSIBILITY**

Video/30 min./1996/Children

"King Alfred and the Cakes" — When Annie's mother presents her with a new bicycle to help deliver her cakes, she promises to be reliable with her gift. Instead, she wrecks the bicycle, along with the cakes, after impulsively accepting the challenge of a race. Plato points out the consequences of irresponsibility in "Icarus and Daedalus" (Greek); the significance of even "small" promises in "King Alfred and the Cakes" (English); and the shame of letting down a loved one in "The Chest of Broken Glass" (Greek).

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: SELF-DISCIPLINE**

Video/30 min./1996/Children

"The Magic Thread" — When Zach's preoccupation with earning money spirals out of control, it prompts him to throw a furious tantrum at home. Plato and Aurora help Zach draw parallels between his own behavior and that of King Midas in "The Golden Touch" (Greek), whose desire for gold becomes an obsession; and Ghengis Khan in "The King and His Hawk" (Asian), who suffers terrible consequences after losing his temper. The penalties of

impatience depicted in "The Magic Thread" (French) leave Zach with an appreciation of the Ecclesiastics poem "For Everything There Is A Season."

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: SELFLESSNESS**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"The Line of Golden Light" and "St. George and the Dragon" — Annie is looking forward to spring vacation until her mothers asks her to help baby-sit her 4-year-old twin cousins part of the time. At first, Annie balks at being selfless and sharing her time, until she learns the value of giving up something in the present to achieve a greater future good.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: TRUSTWORTHINESS**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

When Zach discovers that his college football idol is coming to his school, he eagerly volunteers to help with the preparations. But when he's asked to clean up the auditorium, Zach wants to back out, prompting stories from Aurora and Plato about what it means to be trustworthy.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: WISDOM**

Video/30 min./1998/Children

"The Story of the Two Friends" — Faced with the prospect of attending a new school, Zach wonders whether he is wise enough to make new friends and handle his new, more difficult studies. A story told at Plato's Peak, including a recap of his and Annie's past adventures, helps him realize that he is wiser than he thought.

### **ADVENTURES FROM THE BOOK OF VIRTUES: WORK**

Video/30 min./1996/Children

"How the Camel Got Its Hump" — When a raging storm wrecks Plato's Peak, Sock the bobcat learns "it's all in the attitude," as he grows to understand the value of a hard day's work. Showing no initial interest in helping his friends clear the storm's debris from the Rainbowl, Sock is soon enlightened about the "Fruits of Labor" while reflecting on "How the Camel Got Its Hump" (English/Scandinavian); the message of cooperation in "The Bundle of Sticks" (Greek); and Tom's unusual work ethic in "Tom Sawyer Gives Up the Brush" (American).

### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: BABY DAZE**

Video/30 min./1999/Ages 6 & up

When a baby shows up on the doorstep of Whit's End, the place becomes a flurry of splattered food, dirty diapers and talking sock-puppets. Eugene wants to study the child's behavior in the name of "science," and Dylan and Connie can only laugh at his hilarious attempts at child care. But the baby's short history catches up to him and the events that follow turn Eugene's world upside-down. An evil scientist! Runaway robots! And kidnapping? Oh, my! Eugene must decide which is more valuable — the advance of science or a life made in the image of God.

### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: ELECTRIC CHRISTMAS**

It's Christmastime, and all Dylan Taylor wants is an XR-7 limited edition speedster. However, his hopes are zapped when he discovers its extravagant price tag would overload the family budget. of control, Dylan faces a dilemma — whether to save Holly or win the race? It's a story about caring for others and a rocket ride to the edge of adventure.

### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: A FINE FEATHERED FRENZY**

A garden tool with an appetite for destruction throws Dylan Taylor headlong into adventure. After mowing down Mrs. Harcourt's rose garden, he's forced to pay the consequences, which include "parrot-sitting" her beloved Napoleon. But when Whit accidentally lets the bird escape, the chase is on. Can Whit and Dylan recapture Napoleon before Mrs. Harcourt returns home, or have they met their Waterloo?

### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: GO WEST YOUNG MAN**

John Avery Whitaker has just completed the most amazing transport machine ever — the new Imagination Station. Dylan and Eugene jump in and take off on the maiden voyage to the Old West — and drop in on a frantic feud to save the town of Tuttleville from the dreadful Dalton gang. And when faced with a showdown, Dylan must decide whether to keep his word or run for his life. This is an adventure of courage and integrity.

### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: IN HARM'S WAY**

When the new kid in town isn't exactly cool, what's a guy to do? Being nice is one thing, but letting him hang around with you ...well, that's another thing entirely. Can Dylan see past Elliott's "nerdy" liabilities to his inner value? A critical choice and a powerful lesson await in this tale of friendship and love.

### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: THE KNIGHT TRAVELLERS**

Video/30 min./1997/All ages

Young Dylan Taylor gets more adventure than he bargained for when he saves a mangy mutt named Sherman from an early demise — and winds up in the company of the remarkable John Avery Whitaker (Whit). They set out to retrieve Whit's Imagination Station, an amazing one-of-a-kind contraption that allows kids to see historical events firsthand. ### **ADVENTURES IN ODYSSEY: A TWIST IN TIME**
